6.7: Bachelor of Theology (Pastoral Ministry): This four-year degree is a comprehensive program of training for ministry. The program is built upon expanded objectives of the three-year program, with the basic philosophy being further preparation for pastoral ministry. Additional practical courses and general studies provide a well-rounded program for pastoral work.

6.7.1: Program Outcomes: Students completing this program will:

- be equipped with ministerial skills in evangelism, preaching, teaching, administration, and counselling in order to function adequately within the multi-faceted context of pastoral ministry.
- understand contemporary human thought and behaviour patterns which confront the world and the church.
- affirm the distinctive mission and ministry of the Christian faith.

- have a foundational knowledge of Greek or Hebrew as related to Bible study and interpretation.
- have a growing appreciation of the complex nature of contemporary society allowing for a heightened personal understanding of the needs of the world and the nature of ministry.
